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AIM OF THE COURSE (content & acquired skills)

The course aims to teach students the basic techniques, tactics and a few basic rules of team handball. Furthermore, the student practiced in the referee task through the application of simple regulations. The students must to be able to play the game and be referees in basic form of the game. The results focus on two points: play the game and referee task.

COURSE CONTENTS (*outline – titles of lectures*)

Lesson 1 : Presentation of historical data, Presentation of basic regulations of team handball. Introduction to the game.

Lesson 2 : Getting know the game, basic games.

Lesson 3 : Introduction to shot, basic shot, familiarization with the court. Basic pass, receiving the ball, pass types, dribbling, basic steps

Lesson 4 : Free space, moving in free space without ball, change direction, simple feints, change direction with the ball

Lesson 5 : Basic throw: throw over shoulder, throw from the height of hip.

Lesson 6 : Jump throw: long jump throw, vertical jump throw

Lesson 7 : Throwing from positions. Defense, defense movements, covering free space.

Lesson 8 : Control of the opponent, blocking. Goalkeeper: basic positions, basic movements, ball blocks

Lesson 9 : Basic concepts in game one against one.

Lesson 10 : Basic Steps and play 1:0, 1:1, 2:1, 3:2

Lesson 11 : Learning personal defense (man to man).

Lesson 12 : Playing the game and Regulations I

Lesson 13 : Playing the game and Regulations II

TEACHING METHOD (*lectures – labs – practice etc*)

This course includes 13 two-hour lectures on topics related to motor learning theories and applications, multimedia demonstration, practical application

ASSESSMENT METHOD (-S)

Preliminary examination in regulations (20%), final examination in regulations (30%), preliminary practical examination (10%), Final practical examination in basic technical, tactical and referee skills (40%).
